**State of the Science Reports** AIBS is opening pages of its top-rated publication *BioScience* to professional biology organizations in order to create opportunities for them to present organizational assessments of pressing scientific topics with national or international public policy implications. Your report will be clearly labeled as a product or initiative of and endorsed by your organization, although it will be formally credited to individual authors.

AIBS will provide independent peer review for accuracy, as well as editorial advice, then will issue a *BioScience* press release upon publication of the article and will notify AIBS members. *BioScience*, which has a JCR Impact Factor of 5.51, is available in approximately 5000 academic libraries around the world and is circulated to federal and state legislative and executive branch offices. Publication of your State of the Science Report in *BioScience* will therefore ensure its availability to policy leaders, as well as to the academy. AIBS will publicize the article through the AIBS open-access educational Web site [www.actionbioscience.org](http://www.actionbioscience.org), which receives over 2.5 million page views per year, mostly from students and teachers.

**More than just a report** AIBS staff can help coordinate the release of a State of the Science article with visits to relevant government offices, special letters to lawmakers and others, a webinar to key constituents, or a press conference in Washington, DC. These additional services, available for a fee, can help your organization achieve a greater impact in sharing your policy, scientific news, or concerns.

**Cost and reproduction** Publication charges for State of the Science Reports endorsed by member societies will be substantially discounted from the standard rate for submitting authors. Color can be used in illustrations. Reprints will also be made available to your organization on a discounted basis, and reprinting of the report by your organization in book form will be permitted. Your organization will also be free to post the PDF of the report on its web site.
